

Remove all 4 handles, 2 covers per handle



Use 8mm Socket



Remove the side and rear cover (4 in total)


Remove sun visors, 8 bolts in total



Remove plastic trim



Remove caps to release the carpet






Remove Trim


Remove 7 bolts with 8mm socket




Remove plastic caps, then remove screws

Unbolt and remove bed caps





Push wires back through into the cab


Removing the Wheel Arch Lining



Remove left rear wheel arch for central locking wires



Canopy Fitment



Insert Captive Nuts



Use silicon to fill the gap



Use expanding foam along the base and bulkhead




Feed wires into the canopy, connect break light and interior light. Use the heated rear window feed to connect in the canopy



Canopy Fitment



Feed Central locking wire down the left pillar



Bolt the bulkhead of the canopy in place

Bolt the sides of the canopy in place



Refit Trim



Bolt Canopy into place
