
unpack your fitting kit. Remove your SJS canopy from the box and

- Apply the base rail tape to the edges of the any water from entering from behind of canopy. Across the front rail, apply a the vehicle and the canopy. This creates a cushioning between inside edge of both sides of the canopy. the cabin. Attach another strip to the layer of base rail tape. This prevents run a constant bead along the double double thickness of base rail tape. Then base rail keeping it in line with outside edge
- Lift and place the canopy squarely into position on the vehicle



 Take Canopy clamps and loosen the bolts the pick up bed base rail and under the coaming lip of until they can be fitted over the canopy

- Tighten down with hexagon wrench the canopy & tub. until no gaps can be seen between
- FINALLY For best results put a bead tight seal. Silicon supplied in fitting kit and the pick up tub, to make a water of the canopy between the canopy of black silicon along both sides

CANOPY WIRING INSTRUCTIONS

Note: The customer should be given the option of the canopy being wired to the parking lights or battery. They should also be aware that wiring to the parking lights means that they will have to be turned on for the canopy interior light to be operational and that wiring to the battery means that the lights will be operable whenever. It is the customers choice.

Wiring Instruction - Brake Light

- Remove the right rear light cover, by removing the two bolts on the inside face of twisting (refer to Diagram 3). the tailgate entry carefully pull the right rear light housing back ensuring it is not
- Attach the blue wire from the canopy wiring harness to the green & white (positive brake) wire in the right rear light housing.
- Attach the red wire from the canopy wiring harness to the green wire in rear light housing.
- Attach the black wire from the canopy wiring harness to the white & blue wire in the right rear light housing.

Disconnect Wiring Instruction - Brake Light

- Make sure engine is not running before starting to disconnect wiring.
- For safety disconnect battery terminals in engine bay.
- Open rear tail light cover.
- Remove blue, black, red wire from wiring harness.
- Re secure wiring harness
- Re connect battery terminals in engine bay.
